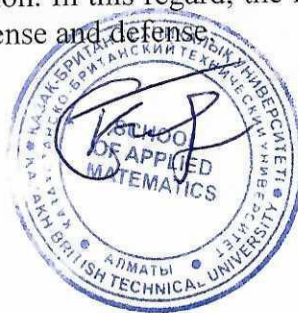

The purpose of creating the Dissertation Council at KBTU for the educational program "Mathematical and Computer Modeling" is to provide an opportunity for doctoral students of the KBTU School of Applied Mathematics, as well as doctoral students from other universities, to defend their dissertations in the direction of MCM. By the order of the Chairman of the Committee for Quality Assurance in Education and Science of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 11, 2022 No. 315, a list of dissertation councils at higher educational institutions that do not have a special status was approved. The personal composition of the Dissertation Council was approved by the decision of the Academic Council of KBTU (minutes No. 1 dated September 16, 2022) and the order of the Rector (Chairman of the Board) of JSC KBTU Gabdullin M.T. The Dissertation Council is open for a period of 3 years until December 31, 2024.

In 2024, 2 doctoral students graduated from the KBTU School of Applied Mathematics, one doctoral student has her practical work ready, and is expected to defend it in 2025. The second

doctoral student is postponing the defense for technical reasons (the publication of the article in a top-rated journal was delayed). Therefore, during the reporting period, no dissertations were submitted to the Dissertation Council for discussion. In this regard, the Dissertation Council did not hold meetings on issues of acceptance for defense and defense.
